

## **Baseball Tour** **Italy/Germany 16 days**



**Day 1** – Arrive in Rome. Upon arrival in the international airport you will be met by your bilingual tour manager. They will take care of all your needs during your entire tour. Transfer to the city centre of Rome for a classic visit of the eternal city with Coliseum and Roman Forums (included). Lunch on your own. Enjoy the afternoon in Rome sight seeing on your own. Dinner and overnight in your hotel in Rome.

**Day 2** – After breakfast, transfer to the Vatican City where you may visit the Vatican Museums and the St. Peter's Cathedral

**(Not included)** otherwise time for shopping and exploring all of Rome.

**Day 3** – After Breakfast, spend time exploring Rome and shopping for souvenirs. Enjoy your last evening in Rome. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 4** – After breakfast, depart for Florence. Upon arrival, lunch on your own. In the afternoon, take a guided tour of Florence and enjoy some free time on your own. Dinner and overnight in Montecatini, a nice spa town.

**Day 5** – After Breakfast, depart for Venice. Lunch on your own. Guided tour of Venice upon arrival. Free time to explore on your own. Check into nearby hotel for dinner and overnight.



**Day 6** – After breakfast, free time to shop Venice for some souvenirs before departure to Slovenia. Arrival at hotel already arranged by your group.

**Day 7** – After breakfast, departure for Regensburg, Germany. Check into hotel already arranged by group.

**Day 8** – After breakfast, explore the city of Regensburg. Guide tour of the BMW plant in the morning. Game in the evening – arranged by White Water baseball.



**Day 9** – After breakfast, depart for a day tour of Munich. Site seeing of the Marienplatz (town center) Viktualienmarket, Hofbräuhaus, some churches, the residence of the bavarian rulers, Odeonsplatz and also to mention Hitler and the 3 Reich in Munich, Bavarian traditions, Munich history and more. After the 1.5 hour walking tour you will have time to explore the city on your own. Visit one of the many museums or possibly make a stop at the famous Hofbrauhous. Return to Regensburg for game.

**Day 10** – After breakfast, relax and enjoy the day as you please. Game in the evening.

**Day 11** – After breakfast, depart for a day trip to Nurenburg. You can easily spend a full day here seeing the sights. Begin at the central market square, **Hauptmarkt**, the most colorful place in Nürnberg, filled with kiosks stacked tall with fresh produce brought in from the countryside. Nearly all the city's attractions lie nearby within the **medieval fortifications**, parts of which still remain. Between the main wall (which has rampart walks) and the secondary wall once ran the waters of a protective moat. At the "corners" of the Altstadt are the massive stone towers, still intact, of the city gates. The remains of dozens of other gateway towers still exist along the ramparts. Crowning the northern periphery of the Altstadt is the **Kaiserburg**. Return to Regensburg for game.



**Day 12** – After breakfast, we will leave this date open for option tours and excursions. Game in the evening

**Day 13** – After Breakfast, day trip to Munich for additional sightseeing and tours. On this trip to Munich we will make a stop at the Olympic Stadium where the 1972 Olympics were held. Also, a stop at the Dachau concentration camp will be made on the return to Regensburg.

**Day 14** – Enjoy your last day in Germany however you would like. We can also set up additional excursions if you would like. Game in

the evening.

**Day 15** – Depart for Munich airport for returning flight home.
