DAY 1 – 02nd July 2010 Departure from Canada

Departure from Toronto. Dinner / Overnight on the plane.

DAY 2 – 03rd July 2010 Venice airport / Venice area (Mestre)

Arrival in Venice Marco Polo airport by Air Transat TS 934-Y flight arriving at 12.05 and **meeting with your bilingual tour manager Mr.** who will be waiting for your at your exit gate with a sign named 'Aurora Soccer' in his hands. Transfer by private bus to Venice area (Mestre). Check-in at the NH hotel '*Laguna Palace*' and time to acclimate, for leisure and relax for the rest of the day.



Dinner, evening at leisure and overnight at the hotel.

Day 3 – 04th July 2010 Venice guided visit – San Marino Cup

After breakfast (at 08.00), early transfer to **Venice**. Arrival in Venice at the Tronchetto parking area and transfer by private boat to **San Marco's square at 9.30 am**. At 10.30 am **half day guided visit** of Venice and lunch on your own in the city centre. Time at leisure for shopping. At the end transfer back by boat

to the Tronchetto area and departure to **San Marino**, the oldest Republic of the world (approx. 285 km.). Upon there, transfer to the tournament headquarter and check-in at the San Marino Cup 2010, then transfer to your hotel '*Grand Hotel San Marino*' and check-in and accommodation. Late dinner at the hotel and overnight.



Venice

Built on 117 small islands and with some 150 canals and 409 bridges, Venice is one of the most particular city in the world Meeting with a local licensed guide for a walking tour in the city centre to admire St Mark's square, the Doge's Palace and the Basilica; during your spare time take advantage to get a water taxi and visit Murano or Burano islands, or stay in the town shopping and relaxing

DAY 4 – 05th July 2010 Training / San Marino Republic & Adriatic Coast beaches

After breakfast, transfer around 8.00/ 8.30 am to a local sport centre for a **2 hours training session with your own coach starting at 9.30 am**.

DAY 5 – 06th July 2010

San Marino Cup – Games - Opening Ceremony/ World Cup – semi finals

After breakfast: **qualification games** start at 09.00 a.m. and continue all day long. Today lunch at the hotel. At 18.00 p.m. all teams must meet at the Multisport centre tournament headquarter for the **Opening Ceremony** and the official teams parade. At 19.30 possibility of a dinner at the Multisport centre or in a local restaurant and Mega Screen for **Semi – final of the WORLD CUP!**

After breakfast: all day **qualifications games**: free evening. Dinner and overnight at your hotel.

DAY 7 – 08th July 2010

San Marino Cup – Games – Medieval Show

After breakfast: **1/4 finals or last qualification games** (according to each category playing system).



In the evening, at 09.00 p.m. by the "Cava dei Balestrieri" in the historical city centre of San Marino a **medieval show** will take place. The show will be organized by the local Association of Medieval Musicians and the Association of the Flag-wavers of San Marino.

San Marino: Lying 657m above sea level and only 10km from the Adriatic Ocean, the 61 –sq-km Repubblica di San Marino boasts and old town worth to visit and the views all around are quite spectacular.

DAY 8 – 9th July 2010
San Marino Cup – Semi-final & Disco

After breakfast: **semi-finals**. This evening will take place a **friendly tournament** among all the coaches whose teams take part in the tournament. They will be divided in: - Team 1 America Selection (representing the American Continent) - Team 2 European Selection (representing the European Continent) - Team 3 a Team made by the Members of the Parliament of the Republic of San Marino (* Coaches who wants to take part in this Friendship Event must register and fill in a special form on arrival to the tournament office on Monday 05th July). In the evening **tournament disco** from 09.30 p.m. for boys and girls participating in the San Marino Cup 2010.



DAY 9 – 10th July 2010
San Marino Cup – Prizing Ceremony

After breakfast will start the **finals**: during this day about 16 finals will be played : according to the category size will be played finals for the **POOL A** 1°- 2° position / 3° - 4° position and **POOL B** 1° - 2° position. Some of the main finals will be played at the **Olympic Stadium** of Serravalle in San Marino. In the afternoon the official prize-giving ceremony will take place by the Olympic Stadium of Serravalle.



After the prizing ceremony, transfer back to the hotel, dinner and overnight.

DAY 10 – 11th July 2010
Coverciano – Pro Training – Florence guided visit

After breakfast, hotel check-out and departure around at 06.30 am am to Florence area (approx. 255 km). Arrival in **Coverciano** National Sport centre and training at



10.00 am with a pro italian licensed coach. **Visit of the Italian Soccer Federation museum at 12.00.**

After the training, transfer to **Florence** and lunch on your own in the city centre.



At 15.00, 2 hours **guided visit of Florence** with a local bilingual tour guide then time to relax and shopping in the historical centre of the city.

Firenze: In a valley on the banks of the River Arno and set among low hills covered with olive groves and vineyards, Florence is immediately captivating. Cradle of the Renaissance and home of Machiavelli, Michelangelo and the Medici, the city seems unfairly burdened with art, culture and history. Your guided tour will touch Piazza della Signoria, the cathedral and other highlights of the historical centre

In the late afternoon transfer back to Montecatini Terme (approx. 55 km). Check in at your hotel '*Grand Hotel Tettuccio*', dinner and overnight.



Montecatini Terme: Spa and Art Nouveau city, Montecatini is a charming spa district with villas, masterpieces of spa and residential architecture, primarily constructed at the turn of the twentieth century and patronized by Italian, European and American VIPs. Montecatini Alto is the old city of Montecatini that is accessed by the quaint red cable car providing stunning views of the squares and alleyways, loved by Giuseppe Verdi who spent his summers here.

DAY 11 – 12th July 2010 **Pisa – Friendly Match**

After breakfast, transfer around 8.45 am to Pisa. Arrival in **Pisa** and free time to spend in the old city and see the MIRACLE SQUARE with its Leaning tower. **Guided visit at 10.00 am** with a local bilingual tour guide.



Pisa: Once, in briefly, a maritime power to rival Genoa and Venice, Pisa now draws its fame from an architectural project gone terribly wrong: its Leaning Tower. But the city offers quite a deal more: indeed the tower is only one element of the trio of Romanesque beauties astride the green carpet of Campo dei Miracoli – along with Piazza San Marco in Venice one of Italy's most memorable squares.

Lunch on your own, time for leisure and shopping.

At 19.30 pm kick-off match Real Aglianese vs. Aurora Soccer Girls.



At the end of the match, transfer to your hotel and late dinner / overnight.

DAY 12 – 13th July 2010

Transfer to Rome/ Rome guided visit

After Breakfast, check-out from the hotel and early departure around 7.00 am to **Rome** (approx. 335 km). Upon there, transfer to the Coliseum and meeting there with a local tour guide at 10.30 am who will give you a briefly mention about history and evolution of the famous 'arena'. (entry ticket not included).



At 11.30, guided visit of Rome city centre among the most fascinating and renowned fountains and squares of the city then time to have lunch in the centre on your own.



In the afternoon, around **4.00 pm**, transfer to the **Vatican City** for a quick visit of the area, to appreciate the imposing 'Basilica of St.Peter' and the 'Pope's balcony' with the support of your tour guide. At the end, some time for personal sightseeing before to transfer to your hotel '*NH Midas*', check-in, dinner and overnight.



Roma: The Eternal City, with its ruined but still imposing monuments, through the imperial, medieval, Renaissance and Baroque periods and beyond, has undergone many transformations and has produced an archaeological archive of Western culture: you would need several lifetimes to come to grips fully with this beautiful, chaotic, fascinating and romantic city.
