



SAN MARINO CUP SUPER TOURNAMENT RULES

(IMPORTANT SUPPLEMENTARY TOURNAMENT RULES & DETAILS)

The following notes must be considered as a supplement to the official tournament rules printed for each playing category. The tournament committee has decided to report separately these information to remind teams, players and coaches the **maximum respect** of the following rules in order to allow a regular development of the San Marino Cup.

THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE ASKS TEAM, COACHES, PLAYERS THE RESPECT OF THE FOLLOWING RULES

A - A player who gets a red card is obliged to leave the soccer field, exiting the playing area and moving to the changing rooms: he can not seat again on the bench. The match will not restart till the player has left the playing field.

B - On the bench can seat a maximum of 4 people beeing part of the team representatives (coach, team managers, doctor) plus 7 players, but only if these people have been preliminarily stated on the player list for that match.

C - Before the game starts, each team must fill in the player list form preparing 3 copies with the names of the players and the number of their Super Card. 1 of these copies will be given to the referee, 1 to the opponent team and 1 copy will remain to the team. In case a team will not deliver in due time the players list to the referee, this will not allow the referee to start the game. Should this situation continue, the referee is authorized to cancel the game and declare looser for 3 to 0, the team who has created the problem.

D - During the match, parent, supporters and other not authorized people, will not be allowed to enter the playing soccer area. Should they enter the playing area without a specific authorization generating confusion and a lack of safety for players and referees, the game will be interrupted. Further referees' decisions will apply.

E - Flying changes are not allowed.

F - Players replaced during the game cannot return on the playing field.

G - Ball throw in can be done only by hands.

H - Due to bad wheather conditions the grass field could be replaced with a field on dirt. He is only the referee that can decide in case of bad wheather conditions if the match can continur or not. In case the referee decideds to stop the match (which can't be then started again) it will be valid the score / result existing at the moment of the suspension. If the match is a ¼ of final match or semi-fnal and if the moment of the suspension there is still a draw between the 2 teams, if possible, the referre will allow the 2 teams to take 5 penalties to decide the winner. If, also this is not possible than the winner will be decided by draw under the referee control.

I - Any player can participate in two categories, as long as the age limit is kept. This requires however, that she/he is listed on the team list for both teams. He/she can not play for more than one team in the same category.
